

**Minutes of the Meeting of Kenninghall Parish Council held on Tuesday 8 April 2008 at the Memorial Hall, Kenninghall at 7.30pm**

1) Apologies for absence were received from Mrs E Dennis, Mr E Wood, Mrs D Rushen and Mr S Mullett.

2) **Minutes of the meeting of the 4 March 2008:** Having been previously circulated were approved and signed by the Chairman.

3) **Matters arising:**

a) **Roads:**

Mr Brown confirmed he had cleaned the bottom of Heath Road. The Chairman reported the notice of road closures, which would be arising over the next few months in relation to the installation of the main sewerage system. It was reported that there are potholes in Heath Road and Mr Gordon said he would email Highways with the details. The Clerk reported the letter from Christopher Fraser MP and the petition will be circulated within the village to see if there is support for a 20 mph speed limit outside the School.

b) **Village Hall Sites:**

Mr Kay said he had been in contact with Bennetts and had a couple of responses. They will take down our fence and replace it with close boarded fence if we wish and this seems to be a good idea. In respect of the Planning application Breckland require letters from the Parish Council (which the clerk reported had been sent) and from the Village Hall Committee. They also require a tree survey. The Village Hall Committee have been paid for use of the site by the sewer contractors.

It was also reported that Bennetts have moved off site at present because they have had a lack of sales.

c) **Charity Trustees:**

This was held over to the next meeting.

4) **Planning Matters:**

The Clerk reported that Dr Lock had been given permission for the erection of an amateur radio mast in his rear garden.

Mr & Mrs Arie have been given permission for the erection of brackets to external wall/elevation to allow access to eaves to roof.

Mr Francis had sent in a copy of his letter to the Enforcement Officer at Breckland Council in respect of 64 East Church Street.

Mr Kay handed the clerk a cheque from Barhale for £2,600.00 in respect of the rent of the land for the sewerage works.
